

Elder's Corner

It seems as I grow older, I ponder on how I got to this point of my life. I remember, I wanted to be able to hear Jesus' voice. Now I seem to hear from Him daily. He explains my life and efforts in the light of the parables. I remember thinking how the disciples had a front row seat at the feet of the Master as He spoke.

If Jesus would walk into church, would we recognize Him? Somehow, I know He would not look like any of the paintings we're familiar with. How would we know that He was the Christ and not just someone with a Messiah complex? I think it would be as hard for us to recognize him as it was for the people of his own time.

He would be carrying a flaming sword or wearing a tee shirt stating, "HEAR I'AM." How can we be like Simeon who did recognize the Christ. Simeon was able to do this even though he arrived as an infant son of a poor couple. Could it be that his daily prayer-learning openness to God and to the Holy Spirit helped? Did this move Simeon to recognize Jesus?

In reflecting on the daily events of our lives and events around the world, prayer is our action. Through prayer we slowly learn to sense the presence of holiness in the mundane and ordinary. These are the places that seem to be where God is most likely to be present.
