







During my recent turmoil, I called upon God to help me figure out how to handle those things that were confusing and draining my strength. Then my heart reminded me how God loves me freely. He lets me freely choose. This choice happens regardless of His will.

When we turn away from God, we are a bit like children hiding their own faces as they cry "you can't see me!" This won't work since we know God can see us. We are the ones in darkness; we are hiding from ourselves, not from him. Regardless, God is with us, watching us, and waiting wide open arms.

God loves us when we are confused, angry, or even if we reject Him. He draws us to himself, even if we don't respond to his call. He is with us, whether we are aware of him or not. That is what grace is.
