As the discernment process continues ... **Keep Praying and Thinking**

We have wrapped up two house meetings in the New Beginnings process which is designed to help us understand our church's current situation and decide about its future direction. It has been wonderful to



have, not just the participation, but the active engagement of so many in our congregation.

During the first session we learned about the marks or characteristics of a vital church community: (1) a compelling sense of "why" we exist; (2) a focus on discipleship; (3) being relevant to the broader external community; (4) passion and energy; and (5) the mobilization of resources for mission. Participants received the New Beginnings Assessment to begin to take in a full picture of our situation.

At the second meeting, referencing our assessment, we discussed our church through three lenses: (1) what we, as a congregation, are deeply passionate about; (2) what our external community needs us to be "best at;" and (3) our resources and how we use them. This allowed us to begin to explore where those three perspectives might intersect to better inform our "why."

As we enter a time of personal prayer and reflection, we ask that you continue to deepen your understanding and consider what might be possible for our church's future. The final two house meetings will be held the weeks of February 18 and 25. Keep praying and thinking ... we look forward to hearing what God has been whispering to you!
