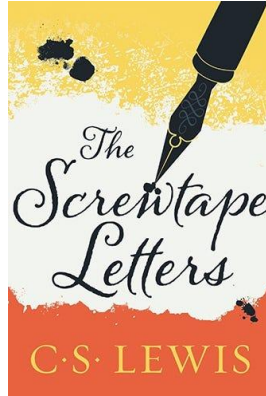


Summer Book Club



Join us this summer as we read the 1942 C. S. Lewis classic, *The Screwtape Letters*. This novel is presented as a series of 31 letters from Screwtape, a senior demon, to his nephew Wormwood, a junior tempter. Through these letters Screwtape mentors his nephew in securing the damnation of “the Patient,” a young Englishman who has recently converted to Christianity and is trying to live faithfully. Through this engaging format, the book offers an accessible way to explore faith, temptation, and the subtle nature of evil.

Our book discussion will take place on Sunday, August 19, immediately after our worship service at the Cherry Hill Clubhouse (2000 Cherry Hill Drive, Presto, PA 15142), about 10 minutes from the church. This is a relaxed setting that makes for a great way to enjoy a light lunch and talk about the book.
